As some of the 70 candidates have withdrawn, **63 violinists** will participate in the first round, starting on Monday 6 May at 3pm. The names of the 24 semi-finalists will be announced on Saturday 11 May around midnight. The results will be announced on our website and social media after midnight.

Programme of the first round

The candidates prepare the following works:

- *Sonata n.3 in d minor* by Eugène Ysaÿe;
- three Caprices by Niccolò Paganini;
- a piece chosen from among 3 *Romances op. 22* by Clara Schumann, *Impromptu concertant* by George Enescu or *Dryades et Pan, excerpt of Mythes op. 30* by Karol Szymanowski.

The jury chooses which works or parts of works each candidate must perform.
